

# Stuff to Pack. . .

Below you will find a suggested packing list. The average high for the summer is 80 degrees and the low is an average 55 degrees. There are some days that get very hot, and some evenings and mornings it's quite cool. Please use the list below as a guide. You know yourself best so bring what you think you'll need for this climate. Please let us know if you have any questions.

## CLOTHING & FOOTWEAR

8-10 T-Shirts	6-8 Pairs of Shorts
2 Long sleeved shirts	10-14 Pairs of Socks
8-10 Pairs of Underwear	2 Sweatshirts
2 Pairs of Pajamas	1 Raincoat with Hood
1 Lightweight Jacket	1 Baseball Cap
2 One piece swimsuits	1 Pair of Hiking Boots/Shoes
2 Pairs of Sneakers	1 Pair of shower shoes

\*\*Due to activities through the day AND Dept. of Health regulations for the dining hall, no sandals are to be worn on camp (**closed toe shoes and socks are required at all times**). While "Croc"-like footwear are technically closed toe, we'll ask these not be worn while working either. However, time off camp please wear what you like. Thanks!

**Camp Appropriate Clothing:** This is a term that our campers are familiar with already and that we would like to make you aware of while you're packing for the summer. Camp Appropriate clothing means that it will not send a mixed or negative message to your campers.

**Female Staff Specific:** Please do not bring tops that allow a bra to show or ones with spaghetti straps. Campers and Staff wear full piece bathing suits. Please remember, campers will want to wear what you wear so be mindful of that. Call Deb with any questions you have.

**Male Staff Specific:** Campers and staff should wear clothing that will be comfortable in a wide range of activities. We ask that you do not wear clothes with logos and sayings with reference to violence, alcohol, drug, or sexual messages. Hats are allowed, but should be worn either straight forward or backwards.
